What is the Mission of Family School Coordinator Services?

The Family School Coordinators offer support to students in general education who are at-risk. Family school coordinators collaborate with school systems, family members, and mental health providers through consultation, wrap around services, psychoeducation, supportive counseling, and community resource coordination. The Family **School Coordinators will support** the greater educational system functioning by collecting and analyzing data and factors affecting at-risk students in order to improve the systems that serve students and families.

Is my child eligible for these services?

To be eligible for these services, a student:

- Cannot be receiving special education services
- Needs to exhibit or potentially exhibit a need for additional support in care coordination between school staff and community providers

What might a Family School Coordinator do?

- Meet with providers and students in care and treatment facilities
- Attend wrap around meetings for students who may be leaving or reentering the district from care and treatment
- Meet with returning students in school to help support in transferring skills to school environment
- Communicate student support plans to relevant school staff
- Home visits with families when necessary to support coordination of services
- Help families navigate community resources

How do I get my child connected to these services?

 If you believe your child would benefit from receiving services from a Family School Coordinator, contact your school's counselor or social worker

Are there any fees associated with these services?

• Family School Coordinator services are free of charge

I am concerned about my child's privacy. What do Family School Coordinators do to maintain confidentiality?

- Family School Coordinators will only communicate with providers if you sign a release of information
- Family School Coordinators follow confidentiality guidelines and regulations
