



Clover Ridge Elementary Healthy Snack Program



Clover Ridge Elementary, in partnership with 112 Nutrition Services, is offering a Healthy Snack Program to the students who attend Clover Ridge Elementary. Good nutrition is directly linked to better behavior, academic achievement, and the ability for student to focus throughout the day. The snacks are delivered to classrooms on a cart and students have many healthy options to choose from each day including low fat yogurt, cheese sticks, fresh fruits and vegetables, and whole grain items.

Families may sign up for the entire year for \$60.00/student or for a half year at \$33.00/student. This is only \$0.35 per day. The first half of the program will run Tuesday, September 3, 2019 to Friday, January 17th, 2020. The second half will run from Tuesday, January 21, 2020 to June 2, 2020. We are not able to give a refund or extra snacks for days students are absent.

In efforts to continue to provide seamless support for our students, parents now have the option to contribute extra funds that help to provide scholarships for the Healthy Snack Program for students that cannot afford to participate on their own. If you would like to contribute to a scholarship for a student in need, please indicate below. Decisions regarding awarding scholarships are determined by Clover Ridge Elementary administration. Student who qualify for free or reduced priced meals do not automatically qualify for free snacks. If you would like to be considered for a Healthy Snack Program scholarship, please contact a Clover Ridge Elementary administrator.
