SUGGESTED SCHOOL BOARD ACTION:

Review capital related budgets

DESCRIPTION:

Each year the district must establish a budget for all funds. The capital related budget is one portion of the budget which has typically been approved by the board early in the budget cycle to allow time for bidding on projects. The capital related budget includes: operating capital, long-term facility maintenance for health & safety and deferred maintenance and capital projects/technology and security levy.

<u>Operating capital</u> revenue is provided to school districts based on a formula multiplied times the number of pupil units. This revenue is intended to be used for equipment, facility needs, technology and vehicles. Eastern Carver County Schools receives approximately \$2.3 million a year in operating capital from aid and levy to cover the needs of all of our buildings.

The <u>long-term facility maintenance (LTFM)</u> revenue program is funded by state aid and levy. This program replaces Health and Safety (H&S) Revenue and Alternative Facilities Bonding and Levy programs. Total levy and aid for FY 2021 is approximately \$6.4 million.

• <u>LTFM - Health & safety</u> revenue is used to fund the requirements to comply with state law and rules of the Departments of Health, Labor and Industry, Public Safety, and Pollution Control Agency as well as any related federal standards. These activities include hazard assessment, required training, record keeping, and program management. Our health & safety revenue to fund projects for next year is \$708,200.

• <u>LTFM – Deferred maintenance</u> revenue exists to fund the requirements for deferred maintenance to prevent further erosion of facilities, accessibility improvements or to make fire, safety or health repairs to district facilities. The deferred maintenance revenue for next year is \$4.8 million.

Voters renewed a <u>capital projects or security & technology levy</u> in fall 2019 which provides the district with funding for ten years. The capital projects levy funds support security and technology for buildings, classrooms and learning at all schools in the district. For FY 2022, the funds will be spent on technology tools, devices and security improvements throughout the district.




