The Eastern Carver County School Board unanimously approved putting an operating referendum in front of voters in the November 2, 2021 election.

The operating levy is a strategic investment in sustaining and building the district's high quality educational and programming activities into the future.

BALLOT QUESTION:

10-year operating levy to increase the general education revenue by \$550 per pupil, subject to an annual increase at the rate of inflation.



IF THE REFERENDUM IS APPROVED

Eastern Carver County Schools can:



RESTORE

lower class size at the elementary schools, opportunities for choice through electives at the middle and high schools, lower fees for high school athletics and activities



SUSTAIN

academic support for all learners through strong classroom instruction, targeted resources, and meaningful enrichment



PROTECT

the student experience in the classroom and beyond by preventing future cuts to programs and services our community values like 5th grade band, gifted and talented services, athletics and activities



INVEST

in stable funding for a strong future and priorities identified in the district's strategic plan

If voters approve the referendum request,
the average homeowner* would see a tax increase of about \$20/month.

	TAX IMPACT	
\$150,000 home value	\$8/month	\$97/year
\$250,000 home value	\$13/month	\$161/year
\$375,000 home value	\$20/month	\$242/year
\$500,000 home value	\$27/month	\$323/year
\$750,000 home value	\$40/month	\$484/year

*Based on average home value of \$375,000

If the referendum is not approved:

- › The fund balance would fall below 5% within three years
- › Future budget cuts would be necessary
- › Another operating levy would need to be pursued
